days later - no wonder it takes me sooo... fucking long to finish an issue!]

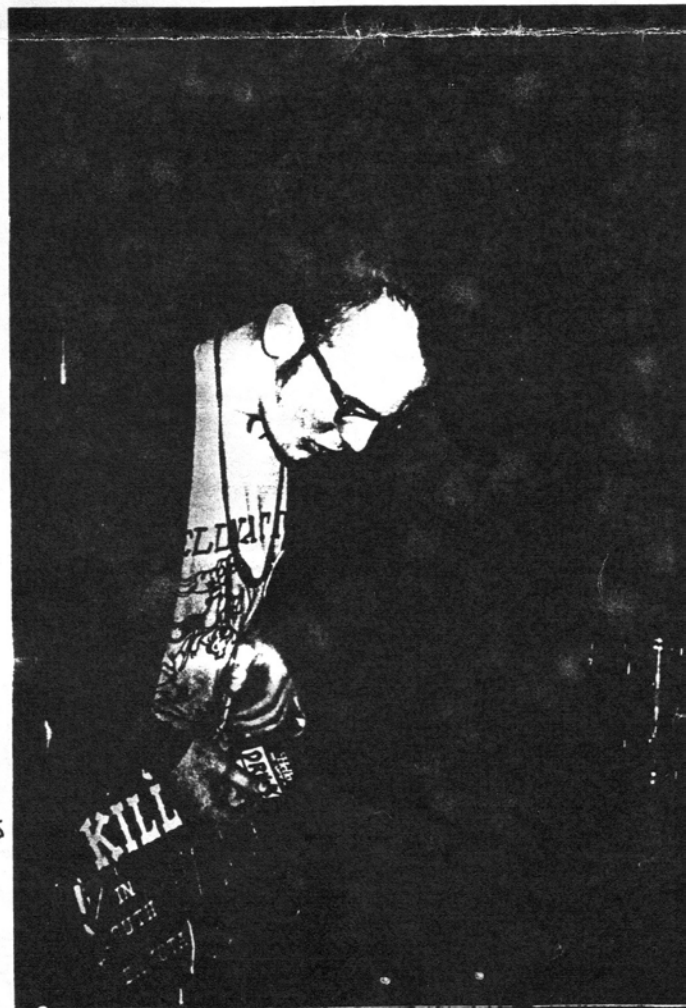

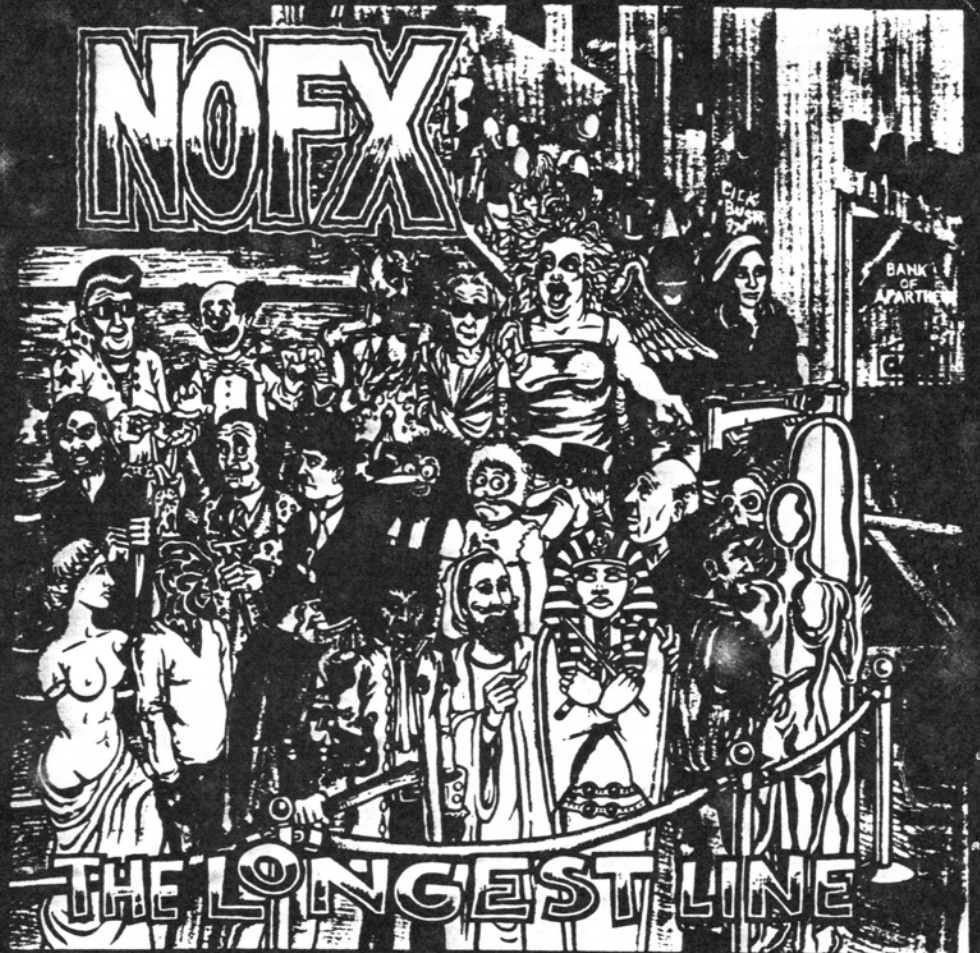

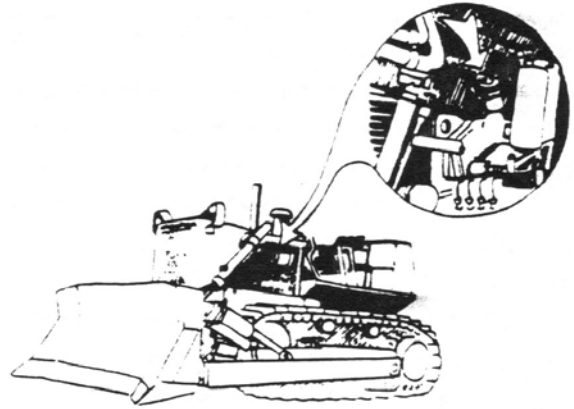
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— PASS THE TIME BY 000 —

(That I know of anyway.)

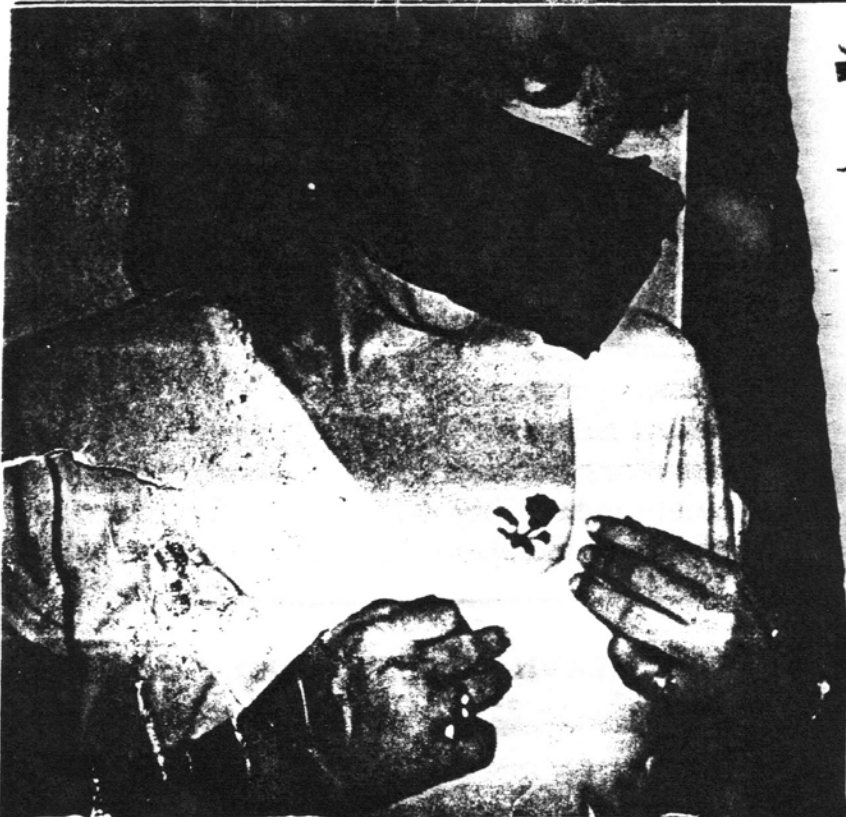
Matches I use mainly for lighting my farts!!! That's about it!

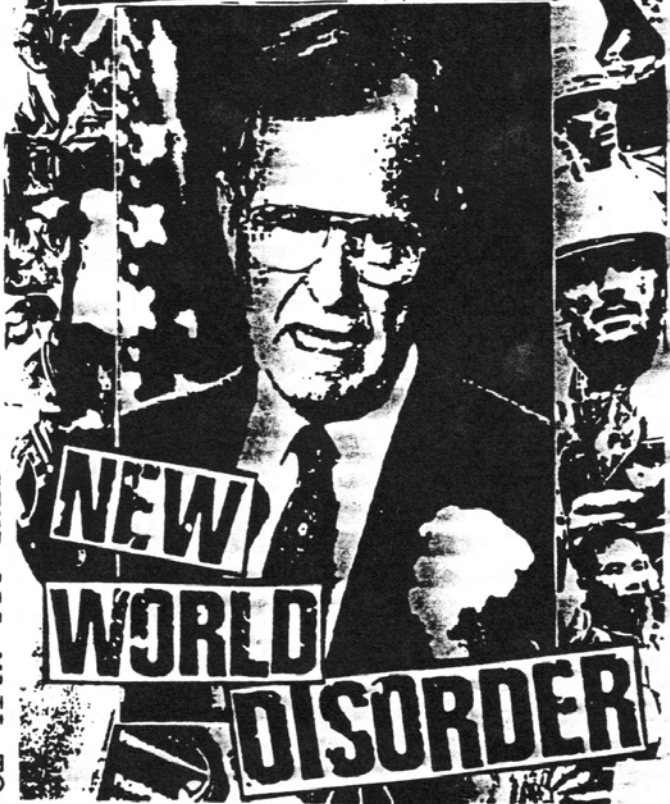

That's cool that it's different. 7 members in this band: 4 lead singers, 2 guitarists, 2 keyboardists, a bassist, + a drummer. Some of them do more than one thing - obviously! I guess I could sorta describe 'em as rock/country rock/soft rock. There's one female singer + when she sings, they sound sorta like Fleetwood Mac + some country band (a cross between the 2). The vocals are sung (not yelled) which works good with this kinduv music. There's also a slide guitarist in this band which is noticeable in some songs - not all tho. Front Door Man was kinduv an upbeat sorta tune that

Teen charged with vandalizing property with indecent graffiti

A Rapid City teen-ager with an obscene political message and three cans of spray paint faces a possible prison term for allegedly vandalizing an area family restaurant.

Brad **AYCH** 19, 306 St. Francis St., was charged with felony intentional damage to private property in 7th Circuit Magistrate Court Tuesday. He was released on \$750 bond.

According to court records, **AYCH** has admitted to spray painting an obscene political message critical of President George Bush, as well as slogans and symbols on the east wall of the Daisy Dell restaurant on Canyon Lake Drive last Jan. 12.

AYCH was accompanied by two other youths who watched the graffiti vandalism but were not charged.

A neighbor chased the youths away. He was able to describe the car the youths left in. The car was later identified as **AYCH**.

The brick wall had to be repainted at a cost of \$622. Any vandalism

causing more than \$500 damage is considered a felony.

A preliminary hearing is scheduled for April 17.

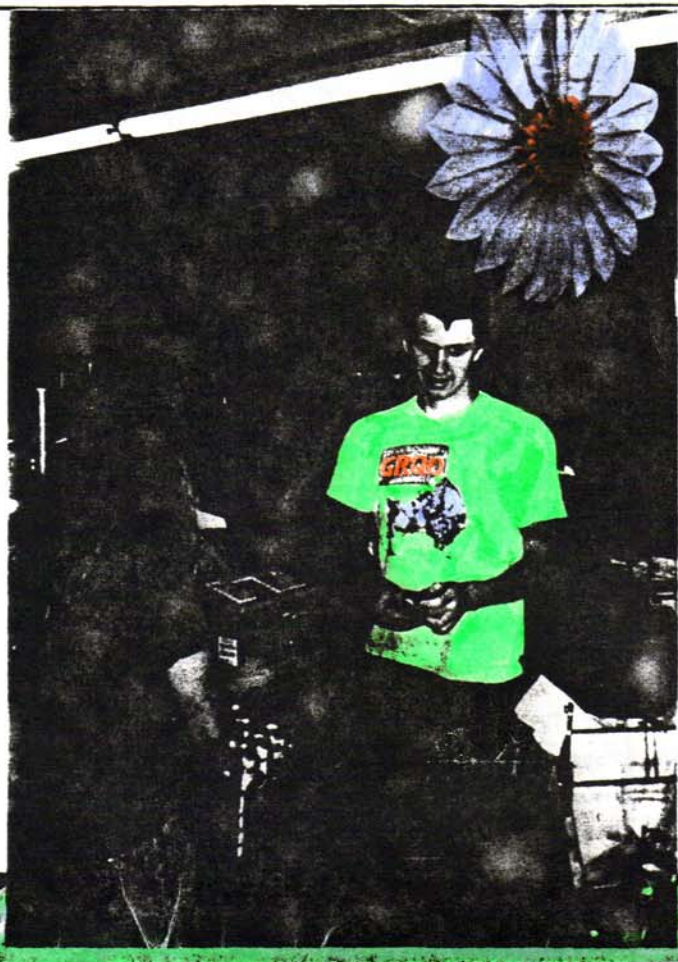
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
